- Ability to teach effectively a range of courses in 20th Century German curriculum.

- Ability to communicate effectively with an ethnically and culturally diverse campus community.

DESIRED/PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Expertise in interdisciplinary 20th-century German Studies, and teaching and research.
- Record of leadership in student recruitment, outreach (K-12, Study Abroad), and advisement.
- Interest and experience in teaching European Studies courses.
- Interest in development of German-American topics courses.
- Ability to balance teaching, research and service appropriately.
- Study, research and/or work experience in a German-speaking environment.
- Successful grant writing experience.

DUTIES:

- Teach German courses (20th century) at all levels, incl. language courses.
- Collaborate with faculty in other disciplines related to German and European Studies
- Engage in research leading to conference participation and publication.
- Active participation in service to Department, University and Community.

SALARY RANGE: Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Probable range: \$50,000-\$65,000

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION: Letter of application that specifically addresses minimum and preferred qualifications and duties in this position description; curriculum vita; three letters of recommendation, official transcript from institution awarding highest degree, teaching evaluations. Employment is contingent upon proof of the legal right to work in the United States. This proof must be provided prior to employment at the University. An appointment is not final until proof is provided.
