Assistant Professor of German

Full-time, tenure track assistant professorship, to begin July 1, 2007. The successful candidate should be qualified for immediate appointment as director of undergraduate studies in our upper-division program in German. Responsibilities will include advising and recruiting undergraduate majors, representing the Department to other units on campus (e.g., Study Abroad, Honors Program), fostering and maintaining relationships with undergraduate German programs at other institutions in the region, and assisting with outreach activities to North Carolina high schools. The appointee will be expected to show excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching and to maintain a significant and ongoing program of research.

Qualifications: Completed Ph.D. (in German, German studies, or related field) at the time of application preferred; two years of postdoctoral experience in development and administration of undergraduate German programs highly desirable; promising or established research record, native or near-native fluency in German and English required; area of specialization open.
